

New Vest Shopping List: Daisies (Kindergarten and 1st Grade)



Ask your daughter's troop leader which style the girls picked.

Find the size that fits her nicely. If she is in Kindergarten buy one size larger.

You'll need a Wavy Flag, Council ID, and Troop Number patches...



Ask your daughter's troop leader for the troop number.

You'll also need a Membership Tab, a Daisy Membership Pin, and a WAGGGS Pin...



Occasionally, girls will need a "Full Uniform", not just a vest. Daisies have the option of wearing the official Daisy leggings, official Daisy Skort, or any khaki colored bottoms along with a white shirt and their vest. Check with her troop leader to see which option the girls picked.

That's it! Your Daisy is good to go!

New Vest Shopping List: Brownies (2nd and 3rd Grades)



Ask your daughter's troop leader which style the girls picked.

For vests, find the size that fits her nicely. If she is in 2nd Grade buy one size larger.

You'll need a Wavy Flag, Council ID, and Troop Number patches...



Ask your daughter's troop leader for the troop number.

You'll also need a Membership Tab, a Brownie Membership Pin, and a WAGGGS Pin...



If she was a Daisy, you can move her WAGGGS pin from her old vest to the new one.

Possible other items... check with her troop leader to see if you need any of these:



If your daughter was a Daisy, she may have earned this "Bridging" patch. Check with her troop leader.



The girls may have voted to have a Troop Crest. There are 16 different designs so check with her leader to see which one they picked.

Occasionally, girls will need a "Full Uniform", not just a vest. Brownies have the option of wearing the official Brownie Skort or any khaki colored bottoms. They also have the choice of the official light blue shirt with tie or any white shirt. Check with her troop leader to see which options the girls picked.

That's it! Your Brownie is good to go!

New Vest Shopping List: Juniors (4th and 5th Grades)



Ask your daughter's troop leader which style the girls picked.

For vests, find the size that fits her nicely. If she is in 4th Grade buy one size larger.

You'll need a Wavy Flag, Council ID, and Troop Number patches...



Ask your daughter's troop leader for the troop number.

You'll also need a Membership Tab and a WAGGGS Pin...



If she already has one, you can move her WAGGGS pin from her old vest to the new one.

She'll need a Girl Scouts Membership pin, too. There are two styles to pick from and she gets to choose her own... Profiles or Traditional.



Possible other items... check with her troop leader to see if you need any of these:



If your daughter was a Brownie, she may have earned this "Bridging" patch. Check with her troop leader.



If your daughter was a Brownie, she has earned her Brownie Wings.



The girls may have voted to have a Troop Crest. There are 16 different designs so check with her leader to see which one they picked.

Occasionally, girls will need a "Full Uniform", not just a vest. Juniors wear any khaki colored bottoms and any white shirt with their vest.

That's it! Your Junior is good to go!

New Vest Shopping List: Cadettes, Seniors, & Ambassadors (6th Grade and Up)



Ask your daughter's troop leader which style the girls picked.

Girls can use the same vest or sash from 6th grade through 12th grade or they can buy a new one when needed.

You'll need a Wavy Flag, Council ID, Troop Number patches, a Membership Tab, and a WAGGGS Pin...



Ask your daughter's troop leader for the troop number.

If already has one, you can move her WAGGGS pin from her old vest to the new one.

She'll need a Girl Scouts Membership pin, too. There are two styles to pick from and she gets to choose her own... Profiles or Traditional.



If already has one, you can move her Membership pin from her old vest to the new one.

Possible other items... check with her troop leader to see if you need any of these:



If your daughter was a Junior, she may have earned this "Bridging" patch. Check with her troop leader.



She may earn these Bridging patches as well as she moves from Cadette to Senior and later to Ambassador. Check with her troop leader.



If your daughter was a Brownie, she has earned her Brownie Wings.



The girls may have voted to have a Troop Crest. There are 16 different designs so check with her leader to see which one they picked.

Occasionally, girls will need a "Full Uniform", not just a vest. Cadettes, Seniors, and Ambassadors wear any khaki colored bottoms and any white shirt with their vest.

That's it! Your Cadette, Senior, or Ambassador is good to go!
